Over 90% of your players won't play another down after high school, but they'll learn invaluable life skills under your tutelage. Many players believe they're going to the D1 school of their dreams when the reality is each school can only take 25 max prospects. Manage their expectations with candor.

Many players shut the door of opportunity on themselves. Explain that they hold their future in their hands. *Grades are the key*.

### TWITTER IS THE BEST TOOL




### TWITTER IS THE BEST TOOL

Similar to a teacher questioning "If you wouldn't go to war without a gun, why would you come to class without a pencil?" Players need to be where the coaches and recruiters are: Twitter. Keep it clean and focused.

If your players don't release Hudl highlights every 3 games, they're not giving coaches a reason to re-evaluate them. Ensure physical stats are updated. Help the prospect by having your max preps updated—especially the stats.

You have the power to expose your athletes to available opportunities. Contact recruiting coordinators and plan visits to local universities. This will show team parents you're serious about helping their athlete get to the next level.



### SPEAKERS TO CAMPUS





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During a recruiting live period, invite college coaches into speak to your players—or invite local reporters and members from 247 to talk to your players. Exposing decision makers to your team provides chances for player evaluation.
